- Mid-County Coop

1. We have started an aggressive program of extra sanitizing.

- We aren't just cleaning the dirt from the gas pumps, we are also sanitizing them regularly throughout the day.
- We are doing this with most of the surfaces (non-electrified) in the store.

2. Fresh bakery products, with a more limited selection, are still available.

• We are individually wrapping each item, to keep them safe.

3. We will be adding polycarbonate shields at each register to act as a barrier to infection.

• We have also marked 6-foot lines in front of each register, to help people keep their distance as appropriate.

4. Hot food items are still available.

- We will be discontinuing roller grill items to avoid customer contact.
- We will continue our wrapped hot sandwiches and boxed hot snacks.

5. We have discontinued the use of reusable cups and mugs for coffee and fountain pop.

• Customers are required to use a fresh cup, straw, and lid each time to reduce the risk of cross-contamination from a used cup or mug.

6. We are getting regular milk and dairy deliveries.

- This includes eggs,
- We are also getting regular deliveries of bread.
